

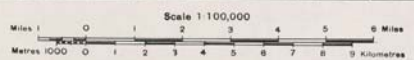

Magnetic North is 0°15' West
of True North and 0°28' W of Grid N. 1941.
Annual change is 5' East.
At West edge of sheet Grid North
is 0°05' East of True North.
At East edge of sheet Grid North
is 0°15' East of True North.

CORRECTIONS TO LATITUDE AND LONGITUDE.
To bring the sheet in LATITUDE and LONGITUDE
into the map into conformity with Survey of Egypt, add
1.2 sec. from LATITUDE and 0.1 sec. from LONGITUDE
taken from this map.

COMPILATION NOTE
The N.E. corner of the sheet from the railway at en-Nasrighia
to Uen-Niger is from a regular ground survey of 1928. The
rest of the sheet is from a rapid ground survey of 1927. The
latitude and longitude are based on a 1928 determination
of SOLUCH FORTRESS.
